Arrival Information

Getting to Fairbanks

Most students arrive in Fairbanks by plane. From outside of Alaska, Alaska Airlines and Delta Airlines provide direct service to Fairbanks. Others provide service to Anchorage, where you can take a connecting flight to Fairbanks.

Getting to campus

On specific days during New Student Orientation, there may be shuttle service available between the airport and campus. Please visit the New Student Orientation [webpage](#) for specific times and dates. There is no cost for this service, but please note that it may not be available every semester. It's also very easy to take a taxi/Uber/Lyft from the airport to campus; the ride will cost about \$20. Be sure to have cash available (in U.S. dollars), in case you need to take a taxi. Ask the driver to take you to Bartlett Hall for check-in.

Moving in

You can move into your residence hall beginning at 8 a.m. on the first day of orientation. If you arrive after this time, and the Residence Life office is closed, you can check in directly at the dorm that you are assigned to. Students are able to request early move-in, which is decided by Residence Life on a case-by-case basis.

Shipping your belongings

It's recommended that you try to pack lightly; don't spend money shipping things you can purchase here. You can send packages to yourself at the [campus post office](#). All international students living on campus are required to rent a PO Box here, and it is also the most convenient way to receive mail for domestic students.

Local shopping

You can buy anything you need for your room or apartment in Fairbanks. We have large retail stores, specialty shops for winter gear, sporting goods, etc., and several thrift shops. The UAF Bookstore and Campus Cache have incidentals.

Local transportation. Shuttle buses provide convenient transportation to all areas on the main UAF campus, and limited service to different locations around town. There is also public bus service.
