Things to know about Riding the MACS Bus to-and-from the UAF Troth Yeddha' Campus

The public bus system in Fairbanks is called MACS (Metropolitan Area Commuter System)



Fares and Passes





BUS SYSTEM IS CASH ONLY (You must have EXACT change \$1.50)

Day and Month passes can be purchased at the Max C. Lyon Transit Center between 5th and 6th Ave. off of Cushman St. in downtown Fairbanks. Cash or credit cards accepted.

A bus token machine is located in the UAF Wood Center near the stairs across from the front desk. You can use larger bills to buy multiple bus tokens (no change given).





Plan your trip

Find which color bus line (Red, Blue, Green, etc.) will take you to where you want to go. Bus schedules and maps are available online and at the Wood Center information desk.

How to ride the bus

- 1. Plan your trip. Sometimes you need to ride more than one bus to get to your destination. Let the bus driver know if you need to connect to another bus.
- 2. Find your stop. Look for the roadside bus stop and try to arrive five minutes early.
- 3. Pay the fee. A fee must be paid each time you ride or change buses unless you have a Day or Monthly pass.
- 3. Track your bus. You can track the predicted arrival time of your bus at your stop with BUS TRACKER
- 4. Take your time. Wait for the bus to come to a complete stop, the doors to open and all riders to have exited before you try to board.
- 5. Questions? Ask the driver!



THERE ARE TWO UAF BUS STOPS ON **CAMPUS:**

- The Blue line stops at the Wood Center and the UA Museum of the North.
- The Blue, Grey, Red and Yellow lines all stop at the UAF Wood Center.

Google Maps can be used to access bus information and create routes.





The bus does not operate on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve or Christmas Day.
