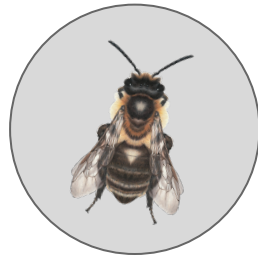




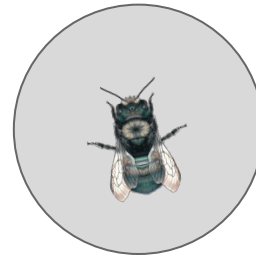
The Scavenger Hunt!

3. Place a check in the yellow circle when you find the live insect pollinator that you see on each sign.



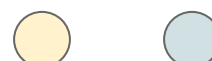

Midnight Sun Pollinators

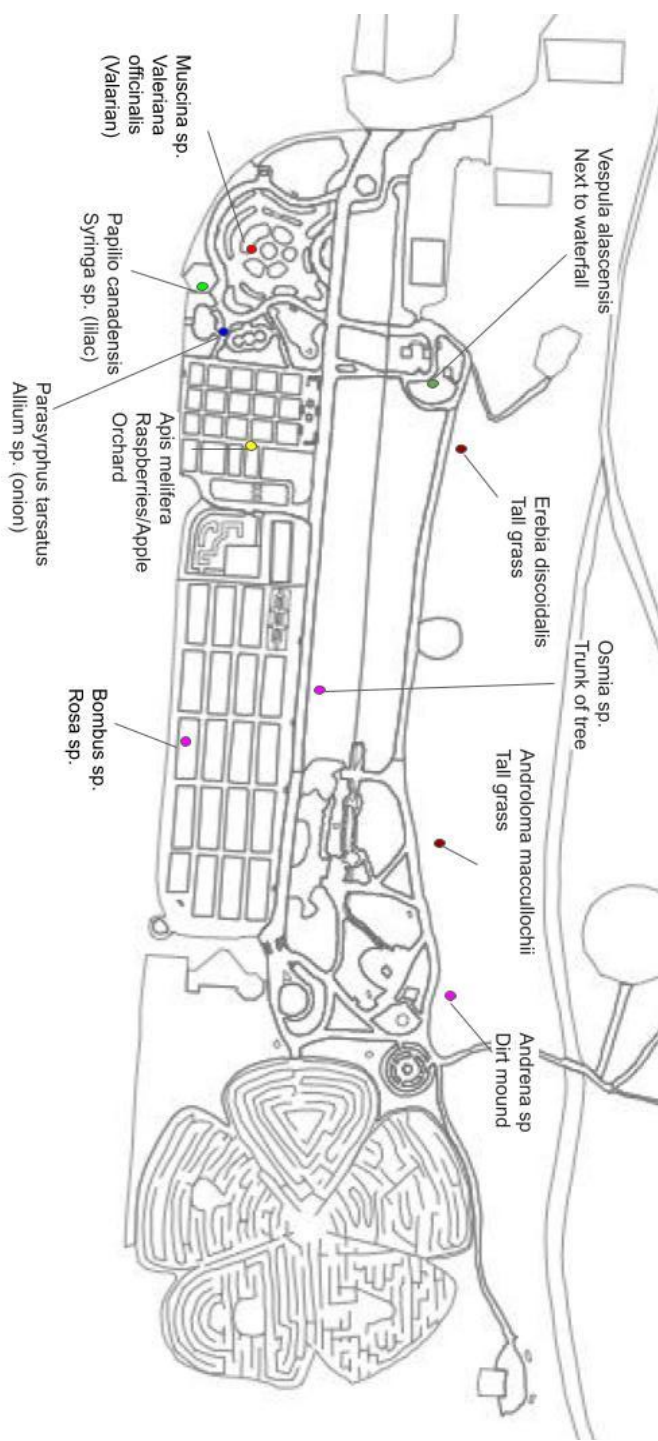

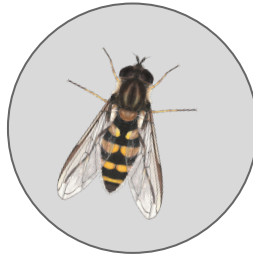
Midnight Sun Pollinators Map



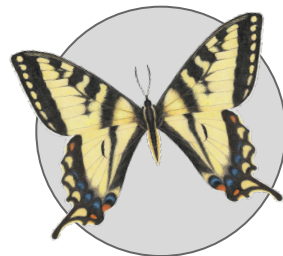
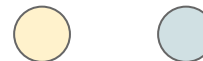

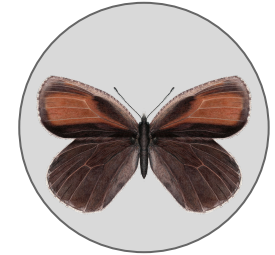
