2. Place a check in the blue circle when you find the display sign for a pollinator.

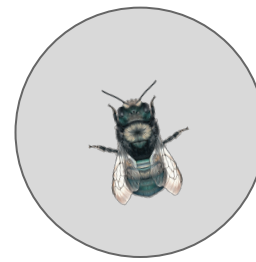


3. Place a check in the yellow circle when you find the live insect pollinator.

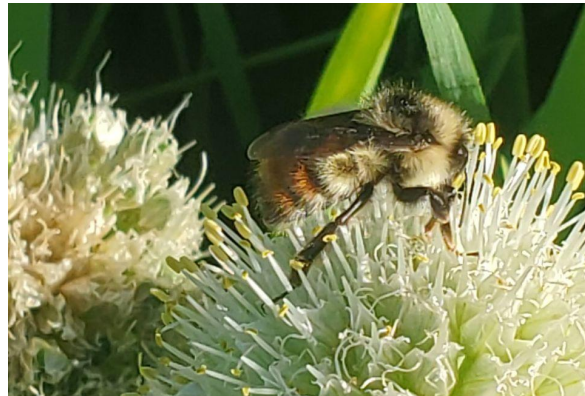
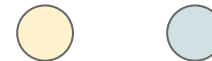

4. Congratulate yourself for being a citizen scientist!



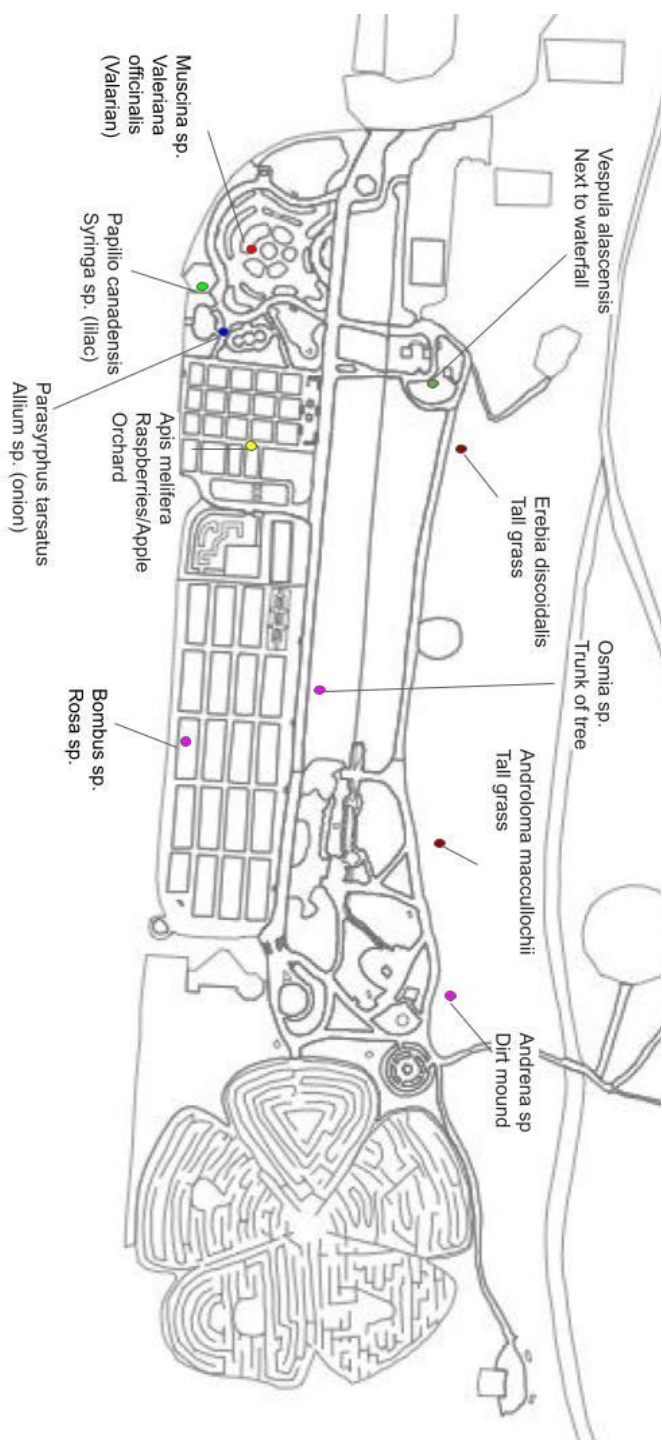

Midnight Sun Pollinators Map

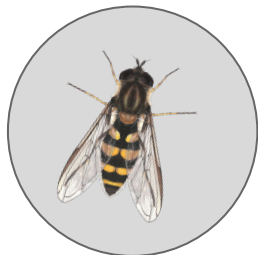

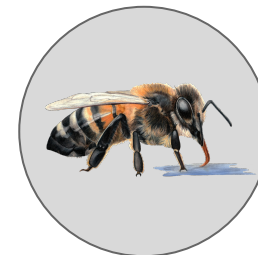

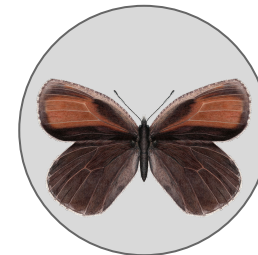

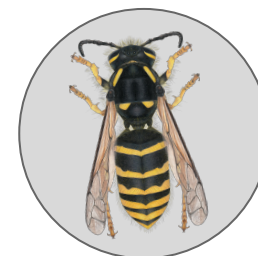
