Assessment information collected			The college of Rural and Community Development has recently undergone restructuring impacting all programs. One significant improvement is the implementation of program assessment protocols which until now, have not been consistently conducted. Thus, while we do not have HUMS program assessment summary data, our SLOA has clear guidelines for assessment as we move forward. Along with the development of a Department and Program Head structure for CRCD programs, considerable work has gone into solidifying the HUMS program as a single CRCD program rather than a splintered program based on modality of delivery or campus location of particular faculty.
			This will strengthen the program overall, allow for a single assessment process applicable to the whole program (rather than parts) and promote stronger assessment and corresponding curricular changes when needed.
