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1. Assessment Criteria from SLOA Plan:

Graduates will secure employment

Demonstrated skill in AFPM 270 and 272

Graduates will pass FAA written exams

Graduates will earn FAA certification

Survey of employers and committee members

Information Collected:

67% gained employment

All students performed satisfactorily in exit exams when their certificate was obtained and/or already possessed an FAA A&P Certificate.

This is not a requirement for earning an AAS degree.

100% of graduates surveyed earned FAA Certification

Employers report consistent high-quality graduates.

2. Conclusions drawn from the information summarized above

The 67% employment rate is not concerning to the faculty at this time because of those seeking employment, all of them are employed. Many AAS recipients continue on with further degree goals.

The SLOA Plan does not adequately fit with the AFPM AAS degree grads and will be amended in future years.
