#### **Tom Bartels**



Tom Bartels, defined as a "constant role model" is an active leader in the Fairbanks community. He built a strong foundation in business and leadership throughout his career starting with managing different departments at Safeway for 10 years, going on to be the Regional and General Manager at The Odom Corporation for 16 years. Then, in 2006, he and his wife, Janet, purchased North Pole Coffee Roasting Company, a small coffee company that originated in North Pole, Alaska and redefined the company as a family-owned and operated business. Today their business model has grown to a large-scale retailer that roasts and distributes the highest-quality coffee beans from around the world. Additionally, the company sells and services espresso machines to cafés, restaurants, local office businesses and throughout Alaska's grocery

stores, and ships their coffee around the globe via e-commerce. Since the Bartels purchased the company, it has grown exponentially and currently provides year-round jobs for 35 employees.

North Pole Coffee has established a strong presence on the UAF campus, being the sole distributor to all of the UAF coffee stands, including Arctic Java, Java Joe's, Murie Building, UAF Museum of the North and the Campus Cache. Between 2018-2019, Tom personally staffed and managed the majority of these outlets working closely with Chartwells Food Group. The influence of North Pole Coffee goes beyond just campus coffee stands. The company's coffee is available at most UAF events, and is offered at various campus locations to help students maintain their energy and focus on their studies. North Pole Coffee participated in the annual Northrim Bank Roast and Boast from 2012-2019 with UAF CBSM, an event where local businesses showcased their products and students got an opportunity to network and learn event management.

Aside from his business, Tom is committed to the community and enjoys volunteering for a variety of charity functions and non-profit organizations including his church, True North. He is also a member of Sunrisers Rotary, and serves on a variety of community boards. In years past he served on the FNSB School Board and as the president of the Fairbanks Community Food Bank. Tom has also been a dedicated athletics coach for youth and high school softball in addition to coaching youth basketball, baseball and helped support many hockey teams.

Tom received numerous letters of support from the community. Recipients are chosen via committee on the merits of community service, business acumen, educational support and leadership.

#### **Building Bridges Through Family Values**




