Shotgun Postal Match

General Rules

- Alaska 4-H Code of Conduct will be enforced for all shooting events.
- Participants must be enrolled in the 4-H Shotgun Project.
- Participants must shoot for score once each month.
- Participants should have ample time for practice and warm-up, then should complete the round except for a rest period if needed.
- No electronic devices other than noise canceling earmuffs will be permitted on the range (e.g. cell phones, range finders, iPods).
- Rounds must be shot during scheduled month and scores submitted electronically to stwilliver@alaska.edu by the 15th of the following month. Results and statewide scoring will be sent to participating clubs and Extension 4-H faculty each month.
- Participants will pay a \$10 registration fee to cover the administrative costs associated with the Alaska 4-H Shooting Sports Program.

Shotgun Specific Rules

- Any 12 gauge or smaller shotgun is permitted, in either semi-automatic, pump or break action (over-under or side-by-side). Shotguns with higher magazine capacities may only contain two (2) shells at any given time.
- Course of fire is the standard American Trap from 16 yards.
- For a target to be considered "dead" it must have a visible piece broken from it, or one that is completely reduced to dust. All other targets will be scored as "lost."
- The ATA Rule Book of the Amateur Trapshooting Association of America will be used.

January Singles 25 clays 25 shells (Jr, Int, Sr)

February 50 singles clays, 50 shells (Jr)*
Doubles - 50 clays 50 shells - 25 pair (Int, Sr)

March 75 singles clays, 75 shells (Jr)*
Singles/Double Combined 75 clays/shells 25 Singles and 25 pairs - *not from previous scores (Int, Sr)*

Scoring

Any contact of a line results in the higher valued score.
**A maximum of 100 additional points will be awarded for safety (50pts) and sportsmanship (50pts). See safety and Sportsmanship scoring guide for more detail.*

Awards

Achievement stickers will be awarded based on standardized scoring percentages based on age and track. See results score sheet for details
