 - e. Driving youth for 4-H activities? (every 3 years)
 - i. Complete driver's training course

 - ii. Successfully pass DMV records check
 - 1. Driver's training forms 2023.pdf
 - f. Not driving youth for 4-H activities (other than your own youth)? (every 3 years)
 - i. Complete the "driver's training opt-out" form
