#### Before Expo:

- Wednesday is a Work Day, required for ALL JML members. This is the day we set up our livestock pens, Exhibit Hall, and decorate the building. Please do not drop your kids off unless they are teens and able to work hard and follow directions. Younger kiddos or those needing supervision need to have an adult stay with them. Please no kids in the arena as trucks and trailers are bringing in pens and large items.
- BRING: Dress for work: gloves, boots, work clothes. PACK A LUNCH! Be prepared to work!
- Thursday: Exhibit Check-In. Schedule your Check-In accordingly.

-Livestock Check-In: 12-4 -Exhibit Hall Check-In: 12-5

Get your livestock checked in, then see Exhibit Hall Check-In team. Do not go to Exhibit Judges before checking in with Exhibit Hall Super and team! Be both prompt and patient with this Check-In! Our judges work hard and have a long day...sometimes you may rush to get there, sometimes you may have to wait.

- BRING:
  - -Exhibit Hall items (4-H projects you've been enrolled in since @ least 06/15)
  - -Your Six Things Learned! Your Exhibit Hall Super will sign this and your judge will also want to see it!

#### NOTE:

-Items brought late or extremely close to the shut-down time run the risk of not being judged for awards and entered as Exhibit Only. Our judges need appropriate time to meet with our 4-H'ers and their projects. Coming just before Check-In time is over does not allow for this and puts your 4-H'er at risk of not having their exhibits judged. Planning to be there no later than half hour before check-in is over is a good rule of thumb for us to best respect the time of our judges!

#### Expo Camping:

- Notify Cassy or Alicia if you plan to camp on the grounds. We need a list on record of all campers, tents, and trailers.
- Camp spots are for KP 4-H families only and are located behind the Sports Center.
- You may set your camper on the grounds Wednesday night.
- Please follow directions for placement of your camper. We are working around a public parking space and trail access.
- · Be prepared to park your livestock trailer in the main parking lot.
- Make sure to secure your camp items accordingly.

#### Barn Duty:

- All 4-H'ers exhibiting at Expo are required to complete Barn Duty.
- Barn Duty slots are two hours long and include the Exhibit Hall, Livestock Areas, Barn Booth.
- 4-H'ers and their adult/older 4-H'er are needed on Barn Duty in each area during all hours our event is open.
- Our Barn Duty boss will have a sign-up poster to be filled at each barn meeting.
- Cell phones are not to be in use by 4-H'ers during barn duty unless in emergency situations.
- Barn Duty is a time to engage with the public and watch over our animals & exhibits.

#### After Expo:

- Expo closes Sunday at 4 p.m. We tear everything down and clean up to be done just prior to our final Barn Meeting Sunday at 7 pm.
- Our north bound large stock is immediately loaded up and hauled out.
- All pens are cleaned, exhibits are packed up, the Sports Center is cleaned.
- Families with small children or who are not JML will move to the Exhibit Hall or to Hospitality to help load up those areas.
- While large livestock is being moved and trailers are coming on site, the only people in the area are to be JML families. No young children are to be in the arena during this time!!!
- Large animals that don't go north go home with their 4-H'er Sunday night until the time of our private slaughter on Monday or Tuesday.
- The final barn meeting is at 7 p.m. Sunday. It is short, sweet, and mandatory for all.
- Clean up is all hands on deck.
- Slaughter day for animals that don't go to USDA plant is TBD, usually Mon. or Tues. after Expo, either Nikiski or Sterling.
- This is a 4-H only day. If we can arrange our slaughterman to do up some private animals, so be it, but we won't know that until then.
- You may be asked to help deliver your animal to a processor, depending on how many animals we have.
- Meat distribution from the USDA plant will be the week AFTER Expo. All families that had animals go up are required to have a designee at this distribution to deliver their animal to the designated processor.
- Small Stock Slaughter date is scheduled after Expo by the Small Stock Superintendents. All poultry and rabbits sold at auction are to be slaughtered this day.

## NEW FOR 2024!

**WHAT:** Beginning with JML Auction 2024, all JML members are asked to provide their own buyer bag to gift their buyer at auction immediately following the sale of their animal.

**WHERE:** Drop your buyer bag with your JML'ers name clearly marked to Ms Jenica on Friday night of Expo near the arena.

**WHEN:** Have your buyer bag in Friday night and it will be ready for your JML'er to come grab and deliver to their buyer immediately following the sale of their animal at auction.

WHY: Two reasons. While one person has been in charge of this very important part of our auction for years, our program has grown to such that it is time for families to assume this responsibility. Secondly, having dozens of identical buyer bags means that those buyers who purchase multiple animals are receiving bags of identical items. It is time to personalize and diversify as we show our buyers thanks for their purchases.

HOW: Put together a well thought out goodie bag for the person who purchases your animal. Bring this bag to Expo and have to arena by Friday night clearly marked with your name. When the auctioneer sells your animal, you will come to the gift table, get your bag, go to your buyer, shake their hand, thank them, and give them their goodie bag. Ms Jenica will continue to oversee the gift table as she has for years, making sure each buyer gets the correct bag.


