

Mat-Su/Copper River 4-H Market Livestock Committee

Scholarship Application



Purpose

The Mat-Su/Copper River 4-H District Market Livestock Committee Scholarships are awarded to the 4-H members that show a strong involvement not only in their clubs but also in the MatSu/Copper River 4-H District as a whole. The scholarships are to encourage the 4-H member to further their education in a college or trade school. \$1000 has been set aside by the Mat-Su/Copper River 4-H District Market Livestock Committee to provide a scholarship(s) for juniors and seniors who are actively involved in the district 4-H livestock program at the time of application and plan to enroll in a college or vocational school for the fall of their graduating year. The deadline is April 15 of the current year.

Procedures

- 1) Applicants must have been enrolled in 4-H and have completed a Project for at least two (2) years, both of those years must be completed while in high school.
- 2) Applicants must apply within three (3) years of receiving a high school diploma or equivalent.
- 3) **Attach a document signed by your school official that shows a grade point average of at least 2.0. No mention of your actual grade point average is required.**
- 4) **Attach three letters of recommendation. One letter should address your character, one should address your leadership, and one should address your community service.** Letters should be written by an adult who can speak to one of those traits, and at least one of the letters must be from a 4-H Extension Agent or Leader. Letters are to be in a sealed envelope. The author of each letter needs to sign across the back of the sealed portion to show that it has not been opened once it was sealed.
- 5) Complete application attached to this form.
- 6) Scholarship funds will be awarded to the chosen applicants after verification of enrollment to a college or trade school (letter of acceptance and proof of enrollment) are provided to the treasurer of the Mat-Su/Copper River 4-H Market Livestock Committee.
- 7) Please include one photograph of yourself.

Incomplete applications will not be considered. (This includes transcripts and letters of recommendation)

Complete applications must be received at the Mat-Su/Copper River 4-H Office no later than April 15th of the current year. Applications received after the deadline will not be reviewed.
