- 2. Complete the Alaska 4-H Volunteer Service Application for your district

 - b. Successfully pass a background screening: this form is integrated into the volunteer service application.
- 3. Enroll in Alaska 4-H as an adult volunteer after October 1.

 - f. ONLY if <u>not</u> driving youth for 4-H activities (other than your own youth)? (every 3 years)
