
- Federal Agency under United States Department of Agriculture



# **Environmental Quality Incentives Program** (EQIP)

- Reauthorized in the 2018 Farm Bill
- Provides financial assistance to plan and implement conservation practices on privately owned land
- Eligibility includes any land producing food or fiber including subsistence hunting and gathering lands





#### **Alaska EQIP Priorities**

- Reduce non-point source pollution
- Improve grazing land health
- Improve forest health
- Protect/Enhance traditionally and culturally used resources while improving ecological function











### Timeline
