## Professor of Marine Science and Biochemistry, Emeritus

*WHEREAS Dr. Button has collaborated extensively and successfully with his peers from a range of disciplines and institutions, from the National Academy of Sciences to the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the National Aeronautics and Space Administration; and has received a distinguished service award for his exemplary work as a member of the editorial board for Applied and Environmental Microbiology;*
