Mapping the TOAD Shared Queries Drive (ie. BlueWhale)

- Complete the Computer Account Request/Change Form and send to OIT for processing
 - Select Computer Login Groups or Shared Drive Path: and enter \\sw-bluewhale.apps.ad.alaska.edu\ToadQueries on the line provided
- Once access has been granted, start My Computer or right-click on the Windows Start button and then select Explore
- Open the **Tools** menu
- Select Map Network Drive
- Fill in the Map Network Drive window:
 - Drive select a drive letter that is not already used by your system. Click the drop-down button to see a list of choices, and select one that does not already have something after the colon. T: (for *Toad*) is a good choice if it is not already used.
 - o Folder \\sw-bluewhale.apps.ad.alaska.edu\ToadQueries
 - o Leave the Reconnect at logon checkbox marked
 - Click the <u>Connect using a different user name</u> link
 - o Fill in the Connect As... window:
 - User name: ua\UAUserName(UAUserName = your login used to sign in to your computer)
 - Password: Your UA password
 - o Click OK
- Back in the Map Network Drive window, click Finish

Now when you open My Computer or Windows Explorer, they should include this drive:

ToadQueries on 'sw-bluewhale.apps.ad.alaska.edu' (T:)

Look in that location for folders that contain useful Toad documentation and stored queries.
