

The State will cut UA funding for the second year in FY16. Tuition and research awards will not fully offset rising costs, leaving UAF with a budget gap of \$14-\$17M, assuming no further reductions. UAF may be smaller in future years, but is

prepared to make strategic investment choices to maintain a high-quality focus on research, instruction and service.
