
Electronic ID Card



My Account login now quicker and simpler



The My Account login process has recently undergone a significant change. This change has been implemented in order to improve the security and reliability of the login process. The new process is designed to provide users with a secure and convenient way to access their account information. With My Account you'll have information about your coverage, immediate access to view and print your ID cards and access to your claim history, including your explanation of benefits (EOBs).

Signing up is easy!

- 1. Go to myaccount.uhcsr.com.
- 2. If you have an existing HealthSafe ID, click Sign In. If not, click on Register Now.
- Follow the on-screen prompts to register. You will need your 7-digit SRID or Student ID/Civil ID/National ID (SACM).
- 4. Enter username and password of your choice.
- 5. Choose a confirmation method. Once you confirm your email, you will need to sign in using the username and password you created.

Crisis Support - 24/7/365 access to prompt in-the-moment services. Beginning with your first toll-free call, our master's level specialists will listen carefully to assess your needs.



Web-Based Services - Our website **LiveAndWorkWell.com** offers range of confidential help to navigate life's challenges. It includes health risk assessments, health/fitness calculators, and other helpful resources.



Self Care - Access to a digital program that provides students with evidence-based tools to help improve their mental health and build life skills. It offers immediate access to cognitive behavioral therapy (CBT) techniques that can be used on a mobile device to help manage stress and promote emotional well-being.



CollegeLife - Provides direct access to experts and referrals for a broad-spectrum of pre-screened and qualified convenience resources for students who may be experiencing issues distracting them from their studies.



Legal and Financial - Students also have access to help with issues such as mounting credit card debt, divorce and child custody matters.
