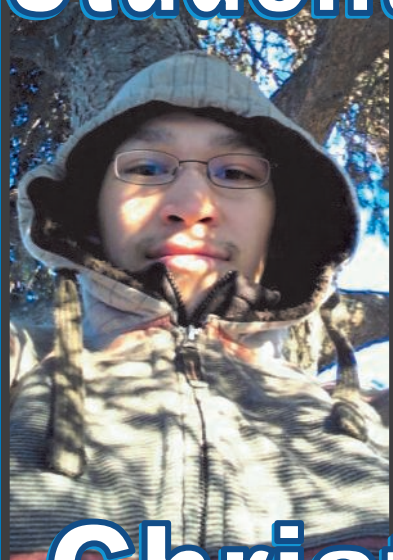

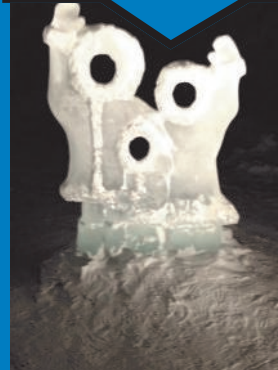


# Congrats to Justice
