



Water Bingo

Explore water in the world around us!

Look around your home or go outside to discover different forms of water, plants and animals that depend on water, and objects we use in water!

Materials Needed:

Printable Water Bingo Card (or make your own), pencil or marker, appropriate outdoor clothes (*if going outside*).

Instructions:

Step 1: Print out a Water Bingo Card, or make your own. A blank template is provided, or you can draw your own on paper.

Step 2: Work with your child to find each of the items on the card. You can look around your home, or go on a walk outside (always supervise children when around water). Mark off each one as you find it. You can choose to find three in a row, or look for all nine items.

Step 3: Be creative! If you cannot find a fish, look for a toy shaped like a fish, a photo of a fish, or even a fish-shaped food!

Step 4: Talk to your child about how each item relates to water. Snow and ice are solid forms of water, fish and other animals live in and around water, insects lay their eggs in water, plants need water to grow, people use boats to travel on water, etc. Encourage your child to think of other water-related objects.



Note: The pictures in each square are examples. You do not need to find an item that exactly matches the picture.

Water Bingo Card
