Weekends @ UAMN

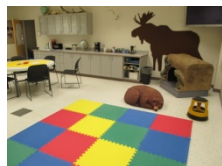
Baby Hour infants up to 1 year and caregivers

2nd and 4th Saturdays. 2-3:30pm.

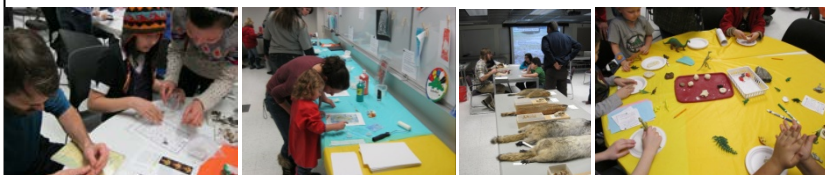
Delve into hands-on museum science and art in the Education Center. Investigate specimens, create artwork, and discover something new. Free with museum admission. Adult supervision required.
