

Regents consider store site

The University of Alaska Board of Regents will consider leasing property to a developer for construction of a shopping complex on UA land north of Geist Road when the regents meet June 3.

On June 4, the regents are expected to vote on a motion advanced by Robert F. Williams, president of the board, that would allow the university administration to negotiate a lease with Carr-Gottstein Foods and Wal-Mart to develop shopping facilities at the site.
