Governor Parnell moved to Alaska in 1973. Graduating from East Anchorage High School in 1980, Parnell earned a bachelor's of business administration from Pacific Lutheran University, and a Juris Doctorate from the University of Puget Sound School of Law (now known as Seattle University School of Law). Governor Parnell practiced law for 13 years in the private sector. He served two terms in the Alaska House of Representatives and one term in the Alaska State Senate, including Senate Finance Committee leadership.

Sean Parnell was elected as lieutenant governor in November 2006, became governor in July 2009, and was re-elected November of 2010.
