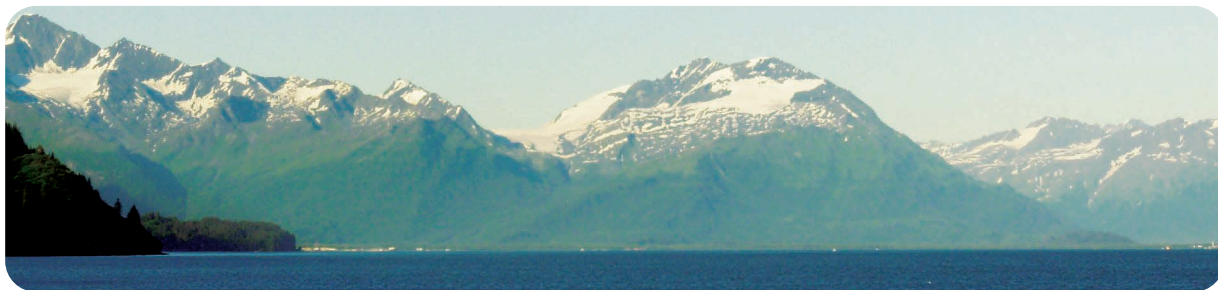
MISSION STATEMENT

We will then head out for two individual day trips on the Upper Chena River to practice and build our skills, and then combine everything we have learned in an over-night packrafting trip in the Alaska Range.

ACADEMIC CLASSES

Introduction to Rock Climbing

RECR F140L T01 - CRN 52568

This Summer Sessions course will introduce the students to outdoor rock climbing. The course will cover anchors, technique, belaying and other aspects of climbing and relate them specifically to the outdoor rock. This class is comprised of four evening classroom sessions and four full day outdoor climbing excursions.

Intro to Arctic Backpacking

RECR F170P T01 - CRN 52402

This is a week long backpacking class into the remote Gates of the Arctic National Park. We will drive north of the Arctic Circle and learn about exploring and hiking in this isolated environment. We will cover trip logistics and planning before the trip. While out we will discuss navigation, route finding and river crossing and other aspects of hiking in the Arctic.

Dates: June 13-22

ARCTIC EXPLORATION

This is a Forth of July Weekend trip not to be missed. We will drive north of the Arctic Circle to the Brooks Range. During this trip we will car camp out of Marion Creek Campground and use day trips to explore the awesome surrounding area. On the first day we will day hike in the finger mountain area to give ourselves a break from the car on the long drive north. We will also do a day hike to Sukapak Mountain north of Wiseman. We will do a day float on the Middle Fork of the Koyukuk River. On the forth day we will head south back to Fairbanks.

Dates: July 2-5

Cost: \$281 for students, \$337 with UAF affiliation
