Our HBCU/MI Program is designed to engage both student and faculty researchers at these institutions via Naval relevant internships and grants. We also provide scholarships and fellowships to support our future STEM workforce. To give you an idea, a few of our limitless opportunities are listed below!

STUDENTS

NRL HBCU/MI Undergraduate Internship Program

10-week internship program for undergraduates to conduct research at the Naval Research Lab (NRL) under the guidance of senior NRL staff.

• NAVAIR Internships

6- to 8-week program for both undergraduates and graduate students to participate in research at a site within the Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR) under the guidance of a mentor.

FACULTY

Sabbatical Leave Program

Provides fellowship appointments to science and engineering faculty from institutions of higher education to participate in research of mutual interest to the faculty member and peers at U.S. Navy Laboratories for a minimum of one semester to a maximum of one year.

Summer Faculty Research Program

Provides science and engineering faculty members from colleges and universities the opportunity to participate in research of mutual interest to the faculty member and peers at U.S. Navy Laboratories for a 10-week period.
