The **Arctic Cryosphere Changes and Their Impacts: Defining a Collaborative Research Agenda** workshop will focus on collaboration and science plan development between UAF-IARC and the Chinese Academy of Sciences. The collaboration focuses on cryosphere/terrestrial processes.

There are five major themes:

1. Glacier mass balance at key Alaska sites and cryospheric services
2. Discontinuous permafrost and surface hydrology in the Seward Peninsula
3. Coastal sea ice and subsea permafrost in northern Alaska
4. Cryospheric services and sustainability
5. Atmospheric pollution and the cryosphere
