

Responsible Conduct of Research

Spring 2020 workshop

The Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) training covers core norms, principles, regulations, and rules governing the practice of research. RCR is a highly recommended “best practices” course for those wanting to deepen their knowledge of ethical research and responsible conduct. It is also an excellent professional opportunity for anyone interested in furthering a career in research. This particular workshop fulfills the National Science Foundation (NSF) and National Institutes of Health (NIH) requirements for formal RCR instruction. This is the only formal RCR training opportunity at UAF this semester.

This RCR training is open to all UAF affiliated individuals (faculty, post docs, graduate students, staff, and undergraduates).

The training is six hours long, with facilitation and administrative support, and uses discussions and case studies to examine basic ethical and regulatory requirements for conducting research.

Topics covered include;

- 1. *Science, Stakeholders and Society***
- 2. *Research Negligence and Misconduct***
- 3. *Treatment of Data, Scientific Record Keeping, Sharing***
- 4. *Authorship, Credit and Intellectual Property***
- 5. *Peer Review***
- 6. *Mentoring***
- 7. *Human and Animal Subjects (IRB & IACUC)***
- 8. *Conflicting Interests and Values***
- 9. *Collaborations***
