



1a. You will be asked to sign-in to your MyJMP account. Select sign-up.




1b. Fill out the requested information.Note: You will need to use your UA email address.






1c. Enter the Verification Code sent to your email.




1d. Read and Accept the Terms of Use (if prompted).






2a. Provide requested information regarding your affiliation with UA. Information shown here is just an example entry. Please use your own course info.




2b. Click Start to verify your academic status.

2d. You'll be sent to a UA login page (SSO) to verify your affiliation with the University. Login with your UA username and password.




3a. Once verified, you will be automatically sent to the download page showing the available software associated with your MyJMP account. Select **JMP Student Edition**.


