Overview:

This session will explain what U.S. export control regulations are and how they apply to university activities. We will identify common red flags for export control issues in your unit or area of research: defense related or defense funded work, publication restrictions, international travel, international shipping, international collaborations, non-disclosure agreements, foreign nationals as students/visitors, and activities involving sanctioned or embargoed countries. We will review the “Fundamental Research Exclusion” and two other export control ‘safe havens’ most often used in university settings. We will discuss what to do when you have a potential export control issue.
