

ROADMAP to DEGREE COMPLETION

For COMMUNICATION MAJOR

NOTE: to graduate within four years, in addition to the courses listed here, a student will need to take one more class every semester, in order to earn the 120 credits needed to graduate. There is tremendous flexibility in choosing the fifth course each semester, and students are advised to consider courses that will broaden their perspectives, and/or prove useful toward their career goals. Note also that declaration of a minor is required; the map here assumes an 18-credit minor, but credit requirements may vary.*You will need to take 18 credits in either social sciences or humanities (beyond the 30 credits of courses required for the major). Please factor this in when choosing your electives.
