AGREEMENT TO PARTICIPATE



Intramural, Sport Club, and Recreational Participants in all Nanook Recreation facilities: Student Recreation Center, Patty Ice Arena, Patty Pool, West Ridge Fitness Center

- 1.1 I am aware that in participating in intramural, sports club or other recreational activities involves several inherent risks of bodily injury, infectious diseases known and unknown, and in rare instances death. In consideration to the right to participate in any of these activities, I shall indemnify and hold University of Alaska (UA) and its officers, agents, and employees harmless from, and shall defend them against, all claims of injuries, including participants and spectators, and all damage to property arising from the use of the facility except for injury or damage caused by the negligent act or omission of the UA or its officers, agents, and employees, or caused by a hidden or latent defect that a reasonable inspection of the facilities prior to use would not disclose. I give consent to emergency treatment, including hospitalization as may be needed.
- 1.2 I hereby agree to submit any disputes that may arise between myself and the University of Alaska, its agents, servants, and binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association.
- 1.3 I am in good health and able to undertake in an intramural program, sport club, or other recreational activity.
- **1.4** All children under the age of 18 (except full-time UAF students) MUST BE ACCOMPANIED and SUPERVISED BY A PARENT OR GUARDIAN AT ALL TIMES WITHIN THE FACILITIES.

Nanook Recreation reserves the right to ask participants exhibiting flu or COVID-19 symptoms, or any individual that does not adhere to facility specific social distancing recommendations to leave the facility.

I am requesting an exception to 1.4 for my minor child (ren) aged 12-17 for the UAF Patty Ice Arena Facility.

I am aware that mychild(ren) will be required to follow any and all posted rules, as well as any directives from Nanook Recreation staff. Refusal to do so will result in them being asked to leave. Multiple incidents will cause revocation of their exception as documented here. I am also aware that should my minor child (ren) utilize the locker rooms there may be adults present with no supervision or monitoring by Nanook Recreation staff.
