

PATTY ICE ARENA USER RULES & CLEANING REQUIREMENTS

The Patty Ice Arena User Responsibilities and Conduct is designed to create better communication between the patrons of the Patty Ice Arena and the Facilities Services' Patty Ice Arena management. It will aid the users in their activities and functions and assist the arena staff and Facilities Services in operating and maintaining a safe and efficient arena facility.

- No one is allowed on the ice surface during Zamboni resurfacing. Prior to the Zamboni coming on to the ice surface all users must exit the ice surface.
- All players, participants, officials, spectators, and members of the public in attendance at any event assume full and exclusive responsibility for their own safety.
- At all times, non-adult participants must be actively supervised by an adult, such as a coach, teacher, or parent.
- It is the responsibility of each user, team, and organization to leave the facilities in an acceptable condition. This includes, but is not limited to, trash and clothing.
- Vandalism or other misuse of any part of the Patty Ice Arena may result in an individual, team, or organization being suspended from use of the facility. The University may seek restitution from individuals or organizations for vandalism or other damage.
- The University is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or misplaced personal items or equipment.
- The Ice Arena and its staff abide by and support the USA Hockey Zero Tolerance policy for aggression and violence. Inappropriate or destructive behavior by players, participants, officials, spectators, and members of the public will not be tolerated. Violators will be required to leave the premises.
- No animals are permitted in the facility other than licensed guide and police dogs.
- Smoking and/or use of smokeless tobacco is not permitted in the Ice Arena.
- Alcoholic beverages and illegal drugs are not allowed anywhere within the Ice Arena.
- Use of abusive and/or profane language is offensive and will not be tolerated.
- Rollerblades, skateboards, bicycles may not be used in the facility at any time.
- Floor hockey is not permitted in the building.
- Balls or any other similar type items shall not be batted, thrown, hit, or kicked against or at walls, doors, windows, lights.

- Pounding on the Plexiglas is strictly prohibited and will result in expulsion from the facility.
- No puck shooting shall occur while staff is on the ice or when the Zamboni gate is open.
- Other than water contained in a shatter proof container, food and beverages are prohibited on the ice surface.
- Approval from the Ice Arena staff must be obtained prior to posting signs, flyers, banners, or other advertisement or similar items.
- Anyone actively participating in hockey or broomball activities MUST wear a helmet. It is strongly recommended that full equipment be worn. All players and coaches must abide by USA Hockey Rules and Regulations.
- All players 18 years and under MUST wear full equipment, unless acting as an instructor.
- Helmets are recommended for all public skaters.
- The Ice Arena Staff may refuse admittance to the facility, or instruct individuals to leave the facility for violation of rules or other dangerous or disruptive behavior.
- User shall ensure that each team cleans their assigned team room after each use.
