Court Line Decoder

<u>Tennis</u> players who need to play a full court game should use Court 2, but if they are practicing in a way that the basketball hoop bases will not bother them, they can go on Court 3.

Pickleball and Badminton are very similar.


- o Most recreational Pickleball players that use the SRC do not have strong feelings about the minor differences and thus are comfortable playing on Court 3. For competition, they should use Court 2.
- o Badminton can easily switch to Court 2 for 2 vs 2, but the court is too different for 1 v 1 and so 1 v 1 Badminton should use Court 3.

Court 1 is very rarely reserved for a specific group, any reservation here needs to go through Nanook Recreation management.

Court 3 has basketball hoop bases that cannot be moved.
