TESTING POLICY

- * All Fall 2021 residents in Moore, Bartlett, Skarland, McIntosh, Cutler, and Garden Apartments are required to take two molecular-based COVID-19 tests on the following schedule.

TEST 1

Taken 72 hours prior to check in date or within 24 hours of check in.

- If you need a COVID-19 test, you can request one at bit.ly/COVIDTestRequestForm by **August 11**.
- We encourage residents to arrange for a test within 72 hours prior to check in, but if residents need to test upon arrival they should make an appointment with Student Health and Counseling Center (SHCC): uaf.edu/chc/.
- If you test prior to arrival or outside of the SHCC, make sure to upload your tests into the SHCC patient portal uafchc.uaf.edu as soon as you have the results.

TEST 2

Taken 5 days after arrival.

- Residents can schedule this test with the SHCC uaf.edu/chc/.

STRICT SOCIAL DISTANCING

**Unvaccinated residents must strict social distance until they receive a first negative test result.*

**Vaccinated residents do not need to strict social distance.*

- Stay in your apartment or residence hall room
- Use the GrubHub app to order from dining services and pick up in Residence Hall lobby
- Do not use other university spaces
- Do not enter indoor attractions (museums, theatres, gyms, pools, etc.)
- No mass gatherings or events
- Maintain a distance of 6 feet from others
- Wear face coverings whenever in public or outdoor common areas
- Disinfect surfaces regularly
- Do not attend in-person classes
