- be a public high school listed in the current State of Alaska Department of Education directory; or
- be accredited by the Northwest Association of Accredited Schools; or
- be a private school properly registered with the State of Alaska Department of Education.

Listed on an active UA College Savings Plan account and have held the account for a minimum of two years prior to the current semester.

The child or lineal descendant of a current Alaska resident as detailed under Come Home to Alaska (Academic Years 2014-2016 only).

To be eligible, students must prove lineal descent from a current Alaska resident through birth certificates or other vital records.

Student must move to and reside in Alaska, and remain continuously enrolled during their course of study.

By submitting this application, I certify that I am or will be an Alaska resident for tuition purposes as defined above.
