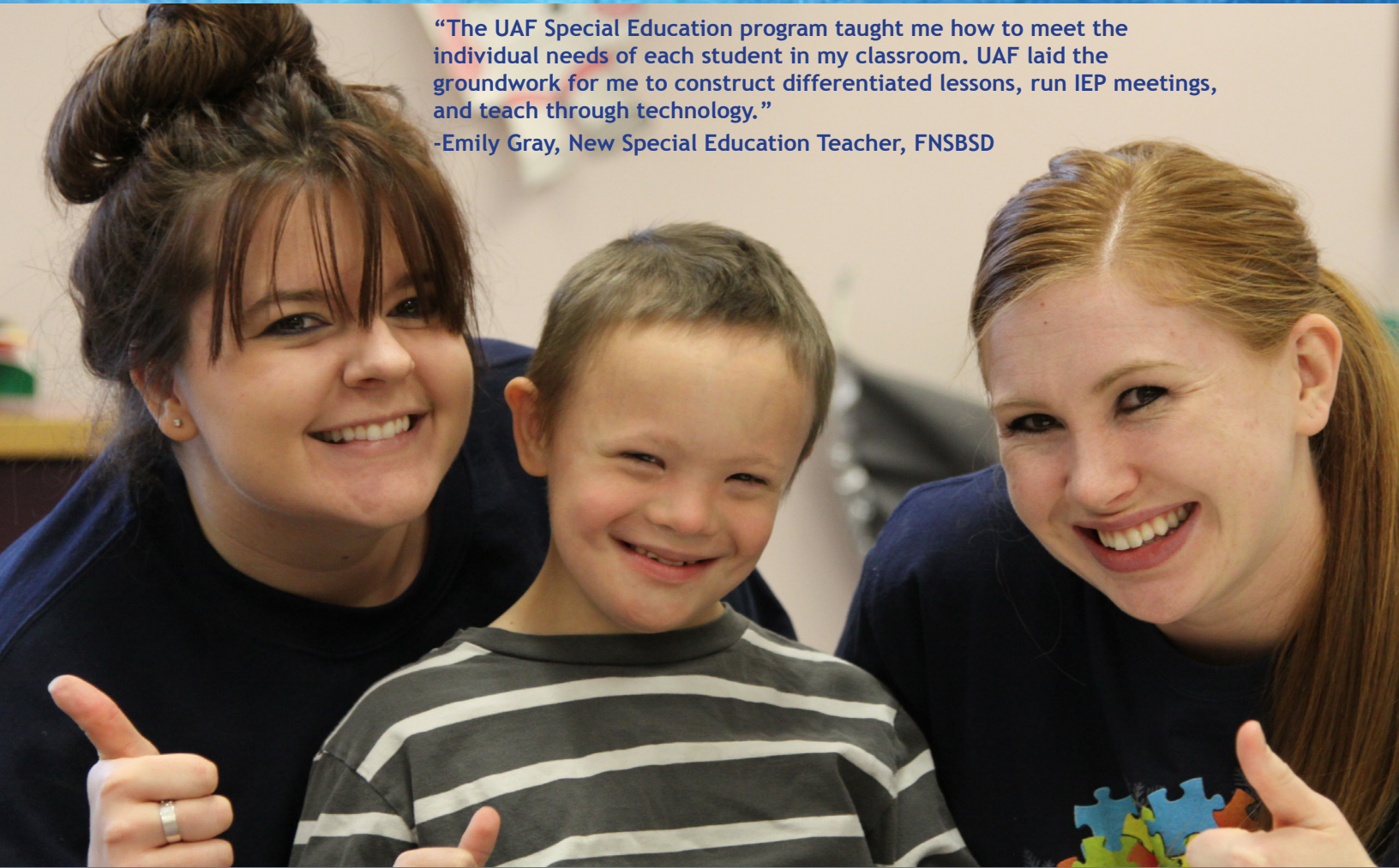

Programs

Special Education Certification

- Post-baccalaureate with current teaching certificate - 24 credits (provides endorsement)
- Post-baccalaureate without current teaching certificate - 27 credits (provides initial certification)

M. Ed. in Special Education

- Master of Education + Endorsement - 36 credits
- Master of Education + Initial Certification - 39 credits
- Master of Education without Endorsement or Certification - 36 credits

Application Process

Graduate Application Instructions

The Special Education program accepts applications on an ongoing basis. Suggested deadline -- for Fall admission: June 1; for Spring admission: November 1; for Summer admission: May 1.

- Request official transcripts to be sent to UAF

Submit the following application materials:

- Online Graduate Application
- Official Transcripts from all colleges attended (UA system transcripts are on file already) Note: if you have transfer credit from another university on your degree transcript, UAF requires the original transcript from the institution that awarded the credit.
- Statement of Academic Goals Essay addressing the applicant's motivations, personal characteristics, experience, education and intentions for earning the degree.
- Three letters of reference -- enter reference email addresses in the Admission Portal.
- Professional resume including education, work, volunteer or life experience relevant to the degree.
- GRE scores if undergraduate GPA is below 3.0.
- Copy of current teaching certificate (if certified)
- Passing Basic Competency Test scores (Praxis CORE, Praxis I, or another accepted test)
- Passing Praxis II or another accepted test score (if completed)
- Statement describing previous experience with children who have disabilities (if applying for Initial Certification program)
- ACT, SAT or GRE scores (if applying for Initial Certification program)
