Visa process for your destination *

Many destinations require students to obtain a student visa or residence permit. In most countries this is necessary only for stays over 90 days, while in a few countries (ie China) you may need a visa for even the shortest programs, and in others (ie the UK, Costa Rica) you can stay visa-free for up to 180 days.

It is your responsibility to obtain a visa, if needed. The best sources for researching visa requirements are: 1) the official immigration agency website of your destination country, and 2) the host university website.

Some countries (ie the UK, Italy, France, Finland, etc.) require an in-person appointment at an embassy or consulate to apply for a visa. The closet consulate may be as near as Anchorage or as far as Los Angeles. Many other countries allow online applications or application after arrival. If you are unsure if travel to a consulate is needed for your destination, please consult the UAF Study Away advisor.
