

Regristration Checklist for Degree-Seeking Students

Select your Summer Sessions & Lifelong Learning course from the class schedule at UAF Coursefinder or see the listing on our website.

Register for your courses in your student account at UAOnline. (If you are having trouble registering, check with the Bursar to make sure you don't have any holds or restrictions on your account).

Secure housing with UAF Residence Life if you intend to stay in the dorms during your session.

No Advisor signatures are required for summer registration, but WINTER and MAYmester courses require a 2.5 GPA or permission from Advisor.

Review the course syllabus for the course(es) you've registered for. They are available on our website under Courses.

Order textbooks for your courses. Textbooks can be ordered online from the UAF Bookstore, or purchased in person at the store on campus.

Payment for tuition and fees for all registered Summer Session courses is due the FIRST DAY of your FIRST scheduled class. See the Dates and Finances page for more details on specific deadlines.

If you are an international student, be sure to complete the International Student Summer Application packet.

Attend class beginning the FIRST day of instruction. Summer Sessions courses are very compressed and attendance is critical.
