This non-traditional book structure is designed to include three-dimensional objects as both image and content. Architectural spaces - including niches, windows, and places where objects are inset and embedded - are constructed within the panels to display collected treasures.

We'll begin the workshop with making a model of the basic niche structure and then create a four-panel box book, varying the structure of each niche to accommodate the objects within. The panels will then be covered and hinged together. Participants are encouraged to bring small found objects to provide content for their box books.
