Bookmaking: Collage as Content (ART F040-FQ1)

This workshop focuses on using the colors and forms of collage to build content. Just as we read from left to right, we will create our compositions progressively from one panel to the next, intentionally including both movement and rest throughout the 6-paneled concertina structure. An adhesive technique using a mylar base and wheat paste makes possible precise placement of elements, from simple to complex. Discrete areas of hand-stitched texture will be added to punctuate space and embellish forms. The completed text block will be cased in board covers to create the finished book
