YAHOO NATION

Yahoo Nation is a political and historical satire which follows the day in the delusional life of the main character, Dutch, who is the star in a 1930's radio program. During the program something happens and he is struck with "Historica Ponderosa Nervosa Dementia" a rare psychological condition whereby the stricken believes they are living American history (and its future) as a Hollywood hero! Recounting true life and adventure of the hero of our story, Dutch, and how he deals with trying to keep fantasy, reality, Hollywood, and nightmares organized. One minute he's doing a radio program, then the next thing you know he's a Pilgrim and the day of the first Thanksqiv-

ing! Note: This is a serious condition, one that is suffered by many Americans, especially politicians and Hollywood actors. Dutch meets George and Martha, has run ins with Injuns and helps Calamity Jane and Gabby Hayes. But it doesn't stop there! There's a 1950s 'A Bomb' scare that leads right into Armageddon where he comes face to face with Jezebel, Bob the Businessman, and even Jesus Christ himself. But don't worry, there's a happy ending.

Written and directed by Thomas Riccio, creator of Fairbanks Drama Associations' PipeDreams, who has been at UAF for 13 years. The show is full of surprises with a true globe-trotter at the helm. Riccio recently returned from China where he and his wife were working with the Miao people, an ethnic minority that has lived in the mountains for centuries and we were doing research on their performance and Shamanic traditions. Last fall he spent a little time in Burkina Faso attending a West African theatre and puppet festival. An article of his regarding Tanzanian Theatre will be out in TDR (The Drama Review) next month and he's working on a few other writing projects as well.

"Yahoo will be unlike anything you've ever seen on stage. There will be audience participation. There will be thrills, spills, adventure and romance! It is also a great example of satire! Political and social satire is a style of comedy that dates back to the fifth century BC and the Classical Greeks. If you like Monte Python, SNL, Lenny Bruce, Conan, Bevis and Butt Head, this show is for you" says Riccio, "this ain't no stuffy theatre."

Riccio is excited to be working with guest designer Dale Seeds whom he met in Cleveland director Thomas Riccio where they're both from. They have worked on other projects together, but never as set designer

/ director. "Working at a distance (he's in Ohio at the College of Wooster) poses some problems, but since he was a visiting professor at UAF last fall and has designed several sets for UAF so far he is fairly familiar with the theatre" says Riccio, who has helped Seeds come to Fairbanks for such projects as The Importance of Being Earnest and Twelfth Night. Riccio feels that since the play is new, they must come up with ideas and images that haven't been applied together before, a concept that excites them both.

UAF did a workshop production of American, the first version of Yahoo Nation, five years ago. At that time the

audience was very helpful with their responses—there were talkback sessions after performances and people filled out questionnaires. Riccio was led by their responses, which were very encouraging and insightful. Many new ideas came from the reading series—for instance the character of "Johnny" was originally stage directions, but people like it so much they wanted to see it as a character. Riccio was surprised to find that many people agreed with the play's perspective of how we as a nation are losing contact with who we are, where we came from and what we stand for.
