#### What's next?

- Once we hire the TPO positions we will get them trained
- Enter into MOA with Tribal Governments
  - Tribes will adopt Law Enforcement and Civil Offense codes
    - Establishes a Public Safety Dept.
    - Establishes a tribal authority for Tribal Peace Officers
    - Establishes jurisdiction for civil offenses to be referred to tribal court (no jail, no criminal charges)
  - Tribes deputize TCC employed Tribal Peace Officers while in the tribal community
    - TPO only enforces THEIR tribal laws
    - Cites offenses to Tribal Court
    - Prevents/Reduces crime rates
    - Local Response to Victims
    - Local Accountability to Offenders in 'real' time
