



Requesting applications for

2019 Truman Scholarship

The Harry S. Truman Scholarship Foundation awards merit-based scholarships to college students who plan to pursue careers in government or public service. Truman Scholars receive up to \$30,000 for graduate or professional school, participate in leadership development activities, and have special opportunities for internships and employment with the federal government.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a full-time junior-level student at a four-year institution pursuing a bachelor's degree during the 2018-19 academic year.
- Must be a United States citizen or a United States national from American Samoa or the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands. Resident aliens (green card holders) are not eligible.
- Ideal candidates would have an extensive record of public and community service, have outstanding leadership potential and communication skills, and be committed to a career in government or elsewhere in public service, as defined by the Foundation.

- ♦ Examples of your public service
- ♦ The graduate course of study you intend to pursue if you receive a Truman Scholarship

Applicants selected as UAF candidates will be asked to complete a full Foundation application packet by February 5th, 2019.
