Requiring students to take a linguistic anthropology-specific course will help the department meet this learning outcome. The department is reviewing and revising SLOA, but the plan is that student knowledge of subdisciplines, including linguistic anthropology, will be in part assessed through an exit interview for majors and minors.

Furthermore, all of the other specific course tirements are for 200-level courses offered in the anthropology department are taught by anthropology lty, unlike LING F101, creating a disparity in representation of the linguistic anthropology subfield.
