Removing the course will mean that students at the main campus will not be trying to sign up for a course that never was and never will be offered.

## 13. JUSTIFICATION FOR ACTION REQUESTED

- (1) This course has not been taught in five years.
- (2) This course has only been taught outside of UAF by non-UAF instructors. The Department of Geosciences had no effective control over what is taught and how effectively it is taught. As described, it covers such a huge range of subjects with so little time on each as to be of little educational value. It's frankly an embarrassment to the Department.
