We have had this language/research tool requirement for many years for the master's degree in anthropology and thought it had been codified in the UAF Academic Catalog, only to discover that it is not, in fact, actually present in the catalog for the M.A. program. We wish to ensure what we have always maintained through advising and construction of the Graduate Study Plan, that all students seeking to complete a master's degree in anthropology at UAF must demonstrate competency in either a language appropriate to their research interests, or to demonstrate competency in a research tool appropriate to their research interests.
