The Department seeks alignment with current trends in literary study by replacing traditional period courses in British and American literature with a slate of courses allowing instructors to approach literature in more diverse ways: through the study of a single author, focus on a genre or particular theme, or attention to literature emerging from a particular time and place. Fourteen courses at the 400-level will be dropped; ten 400-level courses will replace them. English majors must complete five elective courses at the 300- and 400-levels; we will offer the same number of 300- and 400-level courses under the new as we have offered under the current curriculum.
