RE: Division Name Change

Two handwritten signatures are present. The first is a large, stylized signature in blue ink, likely belonging to Daniel M. White. The second is a smaller signature in black ink, likely belonging to Keith M. Champagne, positioned next to the 'FROM:' line.

Following the departure of Vice Chancellor Mike Sfraga in November 2016, the advancement departments of the division of University and Student Advancement supervisory reporting lines were moved to the chancellor.

I propose the division be renamed Student Affairs. The name Student Affairs is more reflective of the identity, mission, role, scope and functions of a division of student affairs in the modern university. In accordance with the renaming of the division, the Associate Vice Chancellor for Student Services position shall be retitled Associate Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs to better align the division.

I would like to make this name change effective immediately to coincide with the start of the spring 2018 academic year. Announcements to the greater university community will be forthcoming.
